FIRST LIEUTEBANT LEO R ABAIR, 0548757, Field Artillery, United States Army. For gallantry is metion during operations in Layte Province, Philippine Islands, on 20 October 1944. While piloting a limison plane, although instructed to return to his base when he was attacked by enemy planes and, also under heavy ground fire, without regard to his personal safety, he continued his mission and successfully adjusted artillery fire which resulted in the destruction of an enemy command post and a large enemy supply dump. Lieutemant Abair's courage was a great benefit to our forces.
